

Bowls Darfield

Code of Conduct and Sportsmanship Policy and Procedures

Rationale:

For there to be total respect of all players, on and off the greens, as well as all other people involved in all aspects of the game, including other team members, the opposition, all bowls employees, coaches, officials, volunteers and spectators.

Objectives:

Participants must conduct themselves in a proper manner, which includes maintaining a high standard of personal conduct, so as not to bring themselves, Bowls Darfield and Bowls Canterbury, or the game of Bowls into disrepute.

Procedures:

Bowls Darfield Club Members will

- Maintain an attitude of respect and politeness towards their opponents and event officials and others involved in the game.
- Refrain from any conduct which might reflect on the integrity of any event at any level or of the game of Bowls generally.
- Refrain from any discriminatory practices, (or making any discriminatory statements) based on age, sex, race, religion, ethnic background, or special ability / disability bowlers.
- Always play to the best of their ability and perform as part of a team (if relevant).
- Refrain from engaging in any form of misconduct on or off the green.
